## CTF Funds Memorial Highway Signs for Transportation Workers

At the request of District 2, CTF helped fund memorial signs on SR5 to honor Robert Jones and Shawn Baker, Caltrans employees killed on the job last year. CTF established the Jones and Baker Memorial signage accounts and matched contributions dollar for dollar until enough was raised to fund the signs, both of which are in Siskiyou County.

Additionally this year, CTF paid for half the Stephen Palmer memorial sign on SR 94 in San Diego County and the Dean Patten memorial sign on SR99 in Sutter County. Stephen and Dean were Caltrans employees killed on the job.

CTF also established the Dick Murphy Sign account. Dick was a long time Caltrans employee, often called the “father of the Los Angeles Regional Transportation Management Center.” Fittingly, his new sign is in the Center.
