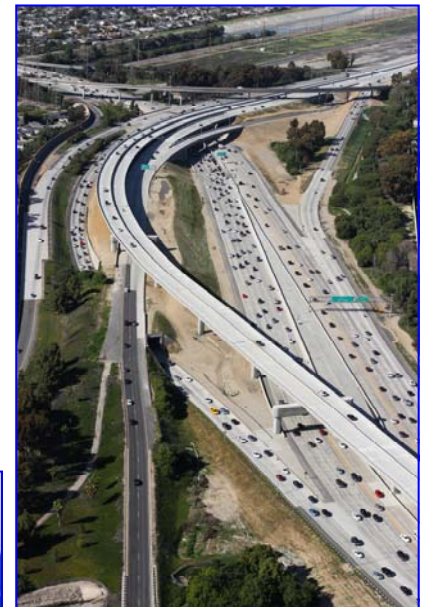
- Project impact
