# CTF Supports Fallen Worker's Family

In January, Thomas "Tucker" Taylor lost his life in a traffic accident while on the job. CTF provided a \$2,500 Fallen Worker Grant to Stacey Taylor, his wife, and established a Workers Memorial Account in his name. Donations to the WMA account have reached \$5,000 and CTF matched those donations for a \$10,000 grant to Stacey Taylor.
