Two \$750.00 scholarships will be awarded to commemorate the life of D'juan Bush, a graduate of Fremont High School in Oakland. D'juan was 24 years old when he died September 25, 2007 from injuries sustained while employed as a Highway Maintenance worker by the Department of Transportation.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPLICANTS:

- A graduating senior from an Oakland Unified School or an immediate relative of a District 4 Caltrans employee.
- A grade point average of 2.5 or better.
- Plans to attend a community college, state college, university or trade school and pursue a career with the Department of Transportation. Careers include: Engineers, Biologists, Realtors, Highway Maintenance, Information Technology, Accounting, Journalism etc.
