The Division of Right of Way and Land Surveys is proud to announce the Right of Way Family Scholarship Program.

Successful applicants may receive a one-thousand-dollar scholarship.

Applicants must submit the following by July 29, 2019 for consideration:

- Proof of enrollment as a 3rd year (Junior level) student at a four-year college or university.
- 1st or 2nd generation relative of a current or former Caltrans Right of Way employee with a minimum of 5 years of service.
- Must have a 3.0 G.P.A as evidenced by an unofficial transcript.
- Majors pertaining to Environmental, Planning, Surveys, Accounting, Engineering or Real Estate may be given preference in the selection process but are not required to be successful.
- A personal statement of 500 words or less, stating financial need and career goals.
- A completed scholarship application
- An interview may be required
